

Strategy Library Quick Start

The strategy library holds every tier 1, tier 2, and tier 3 strategy your district supports. Each one is tagged with a tier, domain, effort level, research source, and rough cost so you can filter down to what you need in under a minute.

THE 5 FILTERS

Filter	Values	Use it when...
Tier	1, 2, 3	You already know the intensity level.
Domain	Reading, math, behavior, attendance, SEL	You are solving a specific content problem.
Effort	Low, medium, high	You need something the teacher can actually do this week.
Research source	WWC, CASEL, IES, peer-reviewed, district-grown	Your principal will ask where it came from.
Cost	Free, low, moderate, high	Your site has a tight budget this semester.

READING A STRATEGY DETAIL PAGE

- **The summary** - 2 sentences of what the strategy does and who it helps.
- **The packet** - a printable implementation guide with materials and timing.
- **Evidence** - research source, effect size where available, and a plain-language rating.
- **Fit notes** - when this strategy works well and when it does not.
- **District rating** - how teachers in your district have rated it with compass icons.

ADD A STRATEGY TO AN INTERVENTION PLAN

- Open the student profile.
- Click **Add intervention**, then **From strategy library**.
- Pick the strategy. Set a start date, an end date, and a fidelity measure.
- Assign a teacher or support-staff owner.
- Save. It appears on the student timeline and in the next care team meeting agenda.

RATE IT WHEN YOU ARE DONE

When a strategy cycle ends, rate it with the 5-icon compass rating and one sentence of what you saw. Your ratings feed the district-rating column so the next teacher knows what actually worked.
